ORDER EXPEDITING CONSIDERATION OF MOTIONS


Came before the Court for consideration the Request for Emergency and/or Expedited Consideration (the "Request") of the Emergency Motion of the Debtors for Interim and Final Order (I) Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 364(c)(2) and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 4001(c)(2) Authorizing the Debtors to Obtain Interim and Final Postpetition Secured Credit (II) Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9019 Approving Compromise Between the Debtors and GE Capital Financial, Inc., and (III) Scheduling a Final Hearing (the "Credit Motion") filed by Mirant Corporation and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, the "Debtors"). After considering the Request and the representations made therein, the Court finds that the Request has merit and should be granted. It is therefore, hereby

ORDERED that the Request is granted in full and in all respects; and it is further

ORDERED that a hearing on the Notification Motion and the Credit Motion is set for Wednesday, July 23, 2003 at 9:00 a.m. in Fort Worth, Texas; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors shall serve immediately a copy of this Order on all parties upon whom the Debtors served the Credit Motion.
