**ORDER AUTHORIZING ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE**

Upon consideration of the Application for Admission Pro Hac Vice of Fredric Sosnick, filed by Judith W. Ross, a member in good standing of the bar of the State of Texas and a partner at Thompson & Knight LLP dated July 17, 2003 (the "Application"); and this Court being satisfied based on the representations made in the Application that Fredric Sosnick, a partner at Shearman & Sterling, is a member in good standing of the bar of the State of New York and that admission of Mr. Sosnick to practice in this bankruptcy case would be in the best interests of Citibank, N.A. and Credit Suisse First Boston, creditors in this bankruptcy case; and

adequate notice of the Application having been given; and it appearing that no other or further notice need be given; and good and sufficient cause appearing to grant the relief set forth below; and after due deliberation:
